The 64th DAE Solid State Physics Symposium (DAE-SSPS-2019) will be held at **Indian Institute of Technology, Jodhpur, Rajasthan** during **December 18-22, 2019**. The scientific deliberations at the symposium will cover a wide range of topics in condensed matter physics, in the form of plenary talks, invited talks, evening talks, seminars, and contributory papers. In addition, there will be talks by **Young Achiever Award (YAA)** nominees, and presentations of **Ph.D. theses**. Accepted contributory papers will be presented as posters, and a few will be selected for oral presentations.

The proceedings of the symposium is likely to be published online by the American Institute of Physics (AIP).

PREPARATION OF MANUSCRIPT

Submission of manuscripts can be made at the website during **July 7 –Aug 7, 2019**.

You will need to create an ‘user account’ at the symposium website to submit a paper. Please **download ‘single column’ template file** (*.docx) from the symposium website to prepare manuscripts and abstracts. The DOCX files of manuscript and abstract as well as a PDF version of the manuscript have to be uploaded at the website.

The length of manuscripts will be minimum of **3 pages** and maximum of **4 pages** for contributed papers, **5 pages** for YAA and Ph. D Thesis and **up to 6 pages** for plenary and invited talks.

Manuscripts not confirming to the template will be rejected and will not be considered for review.

Ensure that texts and figures in the manuscripts are clear, legible, scientifically correct and free of errors.

Please note that only contributed, invited talk and plenary talk papers, provided in the desired format, would be considered for publishing in the proceedings of the symposium.

A participant can submit and present one manuscript only. However, one can be a co-author of more than one paper.

Acceptance of papers will be communicated by September 30, 2019.

Please note that only those papers that are presented in the symposium will be considered for publication in the online proceedings. Only registered participant can present the paper in the symposium. Users would be able to edit/modify the paper via ‘resubmission’ till **August 7, 2019**.

REGISTRATION

Registration at the website will start from **October 01, 2019** and all the researchers desirous to participate need to register on or before **November 01, 2019**
